What CRT is as Defined by its Adherents

- “Training” Example – black teacher – white audience

- “I believe that white people are born into not being human.”
- “Y’all are born into a life to not be human, and that’s what y’all are taught to do, to be **demons**.”
- “White people are all racist.”
- “You’re always going to be racist.”

What CRT is as Defined by its Adherents

- ***Racism is Normal***: ... the usual way society does business, the common, everyday experience of most people of color in this country.
- ***Convergence Theory***: “Racism advances the interests of both white elites (materially) and working-class whites (physically), large segments of society have little incentive to eradicate it.” This means *whites are incapable of righteous actions on race and only undo racism when it benefits them*: when their interests “converge” with the interests of people of color.
- ***Anti-Liberalism***: [CRT] questions the very foundations of the liberal order, including equality theory, legal reasoning, Enlightenment rationalism, and neutral principles of constitutional law.
- ***Knowledge is Socially Constructed***: Storytelling / Narrative Reading is the way black people forward knowledge vs. *the Science / reason method of white people*. Minority status, in other words, brings with it a presumed competence to speak about race and racism. The “legal storytelling” movement urges black and brown writers to recount their experiences with racism and the legal system and to apply their own unique perspectives to assess law’s master narratives.

What CRT is as Defined by its Adherents

Our experiences of the social world are shaped by our ethnicity, race, social class, gender identity, sexual orientation, and numerous other facets of social stratifications. Some social locations afford privilege (e.g., being white) while others are oppressive (e.g., being poor). These various aspects of social inequality do not operate independently of each other; they interact to create interrelated systems of oppression and domination. The concept of **intersectionality** refers to how these various aspects of social location “intersect” to mutually constitute individuals’ lived experiences.

What CRT is in Actuality

- About power. Not really about race, in fact it is racist. It's about aligning your politics with theirs. *Black people who disagree are accused of whiteness or being racist.*
- Utterly corrupt and wicked Marxist worldview
- Anti-God, Anti-Christian, Anti-Semitic
- Intentionally irrational, a denial of truth
- Arbitrarily-applied & ever-changing 'rules' with no grace - None. No forgiveness. No redemption. No hope.
- A weapon of destruction (truth, morality, history, families, family structure, civilized society, order, people, statues, ...)
- A fomenter of racism, hatred, envy, division, normalization of deviancies
- A narrative to justify violence & possibly genocide (Parallels to South Africa)

What CRT is in Actuality

- Manipulative & Cultish, based on false premises & makes false promises
- A wolf in sheep's clothing: Intentionally disguised as scholarly and academic. Plays off compassion.
- Targets children for conversion.
- Pervasive in
 - Schools: public, private, Christian, colleges, even seminaries
 - Society: "woke" corporations, "woke" organizations, "Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion," Democrat party, even many in Republic party, secular conservatives
 - Churches, para-church ministries
 - Our military
- Pursues total control (of the state, of people). People are afraid of doing or saying anything that might anger the mob or get them 'cancelled.'

What CRT is in Actuality

- **Cruel to everyone**

- Horrible to tell a black child the lie that white people hate them; the lie that he or she, therefore, can never succeed; the lie that oppression will prevent them from ever achieving their God-given potential. *So why bother trying?*
- Horrible to tell a white child the lie that he or she is inherently bad because of the color of their skin, that they are and always will be an oppressor and racist - and there is absolutely nothing they can ever do to change. *Keep trying, but it will never be enough.*
- Horrible to pit people against people, family against family.
- Division and Hate (vs. what actually works and leads to great things – unity and love.)

What Students Have to Say About CRT in School

- Skyline (AA) High School 16-year-old Male Student:
 - My voice is silenced, and I am cancelled because I appear to be a white male.
 - My grades suffer due to my speaking out against CRT.

 - Stop the anti-American teachings.

Some Ways to Fight CRT

- Be informed, alert, and prepared.
 - Know truth; be confident in who you are.
 - Define terms; don't use their terms without knowing what they really mean and how the other person defines those terms.
- Have courage!
 - Don't be afraid - you WILL be attacked; you may very well lose friends.
 - Don't cower or back down when you are called names such as racist or bigot.
 - Don't value momentary comfort over truth.
 - You are fighting a good and necessary fight.
- Gather up, be vocal, and hold representatives accountable - school boards, teachers, politicians, leaders of organizations...
 - Recalls, lawsuits, boycott woke companies and sports teams...
 - Run for office yourself. Support like-minded people who do.
- Protect your children. You may have to pull them out of school.
- Value and express your value of individual people. Love people with truth.

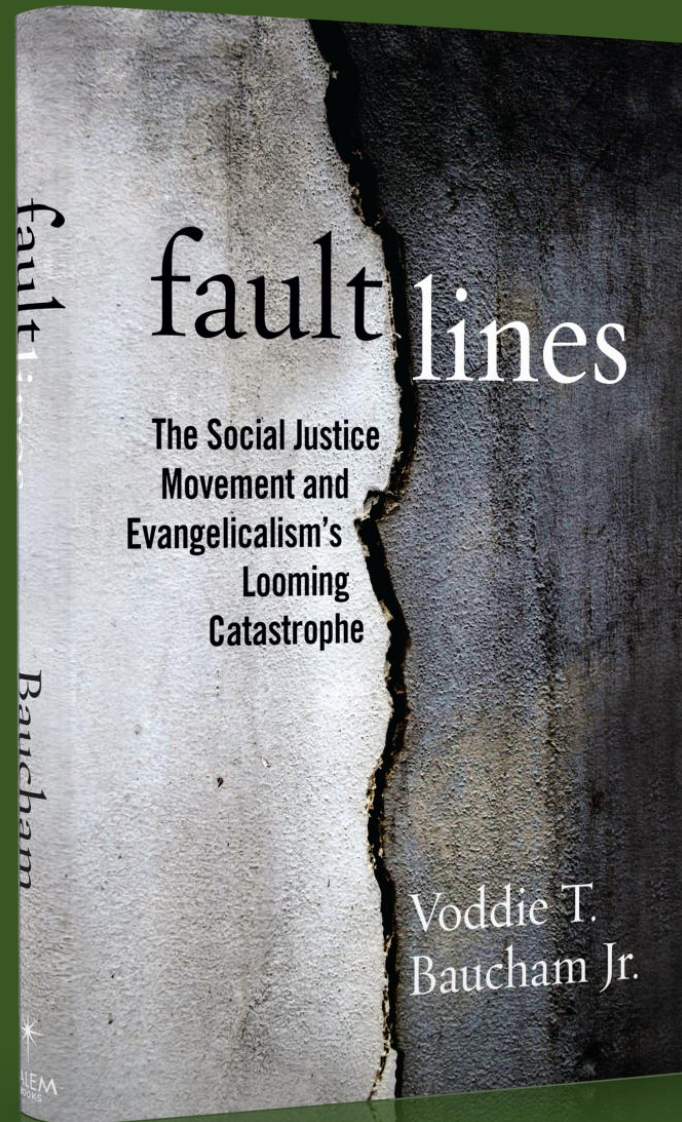

Truth AND Love

- Recognize that there are people who are not informed about CRT, but only know on the surface that they genuinely want to be good people. These are people who fall for the clever usage of terms that sound good. *For example, of course we all value justice in society. If someone commits a crime, they should suffer the just penalty for said crime, with that penalty applied equally to anyone who commits the same crime in the same circumstances.* The term “social justice” sounds to them like a good thing. But they don’t know what “social justice” is in the vernacular of CRT.
- Recognize that there are people who are deceived, maybe afraid of being called racist, probably genuinely wanting to do the right thing and eliminate racism. *These people don’t adhere to CRT because they’re evil. They’re just deceived.* Love them and encourage them to think for themselves by gently asking questions that will bring them to rational conclusions.
- Recognize that there are people who use CRT for personal gain. Their motives are **EVIL**. They apply CRT to use peoples’ genuine experiences and pain—abusing them by magnifying and personalizing some personal experiences or even stories of experiences of others as if they are the pervasive and universal experience of ALL people in whatever group with which they identify. *These people want to destroy civilization—and they need to be called out for it. Directly, firmly, publicly, with ridicule where appropriate.*

Problems with CRT

- CRT represents “an attack on rationality” that calls for an abandonment of objectivity and for a dependence on individual subjective perspectives. Truth is irrelevant. What CRT posits as relevant is their perception about what incentive someone has for making a claim. Motive trumps accuracy or if a claim corresponds to reality.
- CRT stifles free intellectual inquiry and personal rationalization. Instead, individuals are required to conform to group-think.
- CRT shuts down debate and inquiry on the basis of its presupposed assumptions
- CRT diverts attention away from the true causes of the Social Pathologies of the Black Community in the US and around the world.

- * Critical race theory entirely violates a biblical worldview, however, by suggesting that people are essentially defined by their race or class, rather than by their individual acts and attitudes ([Jeremiah 31:31–34](#); [Revelation 20:11–13](#)).
- * Critical race theory incorrectly emphasizes intersectional categories such as gender, race, sexual preference, and economic status above and beyond a person's own choices and responsibilities ([Galatians 3:28](#)).
- * Critical race theory also conflicts with a biblical approach to objective, absolute truth. In no small part, this includes suggesting that an “oppressed” person's feelings matter more than what the “oppressor” has actually done or intended ([1 Corinthians 4:4](#); [10:29](#)).

¹ My brothers, show no partiality as you hold the faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory. ² For if a man wearing a gold ring and fine clothing comes into your assembly, and a poor man in shabby clothing also comes in, ³ and if you pay attention to the one who wears the fine clothing and say, “You sit here in a good place,” while you say to the poor man, “You stand over there,” or, “Sit down at my feet,” ⁴ have you not then made distinctions among yourselves and become judges with evil thoughts?

James 2:8-9

⁸ If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, “You shall love your neighbor as yourself,” you are doing well. ⁹ But if you show partiality, you are committing sin and are convicted by the law as transgressors.
